## TUITION AND FEES 2010-2011 SCHOOL YEAR

<b>Express Registration Fee</b> (March 22 - April 1), returning students only.....	<b>\$125</b>
<b>Open Registration Fee</b> .....	<b>\$350</b>
<b>Pre-K-Grade 5</b> .....	<b>\$5,515</b>
<b>Grades 6-8</b> .....	<b>\$5,775</b>
<b>Grades 9-12</b> .....	<b>\$6,065</b>

**Registration Fee** is in addition to annual tuition, and it reserves a student's space at Baytown Christian Academy. A student is considered registered once the student has been accepted and the registration fee paid. This fee enables the school to make financial commitments for the coming year. Every family pays one registration fee per year per student; either Express or Open (see below). *Registration fees are non-refundable.*

**Express Registration (March 22 – April 1, 2010)** is for families who currently have students enrolled at Baytown Christian Academy. Families may re-enroll current students during this period. The express registration fee for a returning student must be paid in full. Submitting an application and fee for a new sibling by April 1 guarantees that, if that student is accepted, his/her parents will be able to pay the registration fee at the express rate at the time of acceptance.

**Open Registration (begins April 5, 2010)** is for current families who decline to use express registration and for all families new to Baytown Christian Academy. Open registration fees must be paid in full at enrollment.

*Please note that current students are guaranteed their spaces for the next year only if they are enrolled during Express Registration.*

**Tuition** pays toward the cost of instruction at Baytown Christian Academy. In addition to tuition, families pay certain additional expenses to cover field trips, uniforms, and sports fees, as well as other activities that are chosen during the school year.

### **Tuition Payment Options:**

- ◆ **Payment in Full:** Tuition will be paid in full by June 15, 2010. There will be a 3% discount.
- ◆ **Semester:** Tuition may be paid in two equal installments with the first installment due at the time of registration and the second payment on or before December 16, 2010.
- ◆ **Monthly:** Monthly payments begin in June. The tuition balance will be divided evenly throughout the remainder of the year and will be handled by FACTS, a third-party company. FACTS charges an annual fee of \$41.

**Fundraiser Buyout:** Parents can eliminate participating in school fundraisers by making a donation of \$350 per student at the time of registration.

**Extended Care:** Childcare is available for students through 4<sup>th</sup> grade.

Registration Fee: \$65 per family

Morning Care (6 a.m. to start of school): \$25 per student per week

Afternoon Care (end of school to 6 p.m.): \$55 per student per week

**Family Tuition Discount:** Families with two students will receive a 10% discount on total tuition. Families with three or more students will receive a 15% discount on total tuition.

**Tuition Assistance:** A limited amount of tuition assistance will be available to current BCA families. Applications are available in the financial office.

**Refund Policy:** By signing the **Admissions & Financial Contract**, the parent/guardian shall be responsible for the entire contractual amount whether or not the student attends classes, or if the student voluntarily withdraws or is expelled from school prior to the end of the academic year. The school specifically reserves the right to hold transcripts, report cards, and not allow final exams to be administered for students until all tuition and fees are current.
